



Assembly

1. Unfold the creeper
2. Remove the bag containing the casters and the open-end wrench from the packaging.
3. Use the provided open-end wrench to attach the casters to the head frame. Hand tighten with open end wrench.
4. Use a 5 mm hex-key to attach the remaining casters to the rear frame. Insert the threaded fasteners from above, then insert the casters from below (as seen in Fig. 1), then hand tighten with hex-key.

Figure 1 - Components





Figure 2 - Creeper to Seat Configuration





Figure 3 - Seat to Creeper Configuration



Operating Instructions



Keep hands away from pinch and crush points that are created during use! Be alert when using this product! Never operate this equipment when under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

1. Locate the spring loaded Lock Pin, then unlock by pulling out until disengaged. At the same time flip the Head Frame and Middle Frame upward and back towards the Rear Frame section until the Lock Pin can engage the Creeper Seat Locking Sleeve (Fig. 2). Ensure Lock Pin is fully engaged.
2. Flip the Head Frame forward until horizontal.
3. Unlock the spring loaded Lock Pin by pulling out until disengaged, then reverse steps 1, 2 to convert Creeper Seat into Creeper (Fig. 3).
